IMPORTANT EVENT INFORMATION FOR ENSEMBLES

Check-in:

The Director Check-In table is in the by the bus entry. Packets will only be distributed to directors unless other arrangements are made in advance.

Parking Information:

The McQ campus is limited with respect to parking large vehicles. The information you provided on your entry form (number of buses, etc.) has been used to create a parking plan. Please communicate to the parents who may be traveling with you in personal vehicles to use the spectator parking entrance and lot. General Parking will be in the back parking and faculty parking lot next to the football field. Parking for buses, trailers, etc., will be mapped out for you. Please see the attached parking map for ensemble parking.

Restrooms:

Restrooms will be available in the stadium and near the bus parking area. Please see the attached map for restroom locations.

Health & Safety:

A small first-aid tent will be set up near the entry to the stadium. Only basic first-aid items will be available.

Music Warm Up Areas:

Ensembles can warm up in their parking area anytime, facing away from the school and other bands actively warming up. Amplified sounds such as Dr. Beats and front ensemble speakers are permitted; please keep all speakers facing towards Robb Drive and be mindful of volume. Drumlines may warm up on the grass near the front of the school. Color Guards may use the basketball courts to warm up; please point speakers away from the competition area and be mindful of volume.

The campus's upper lot and east side past the basketball courts are quiet zones after 1 pm.

Props and other Equipment:

Props and other equipment may be staged near the field in the designated area marked on the map. Please make sure you have adequate staff and volunteers to assist in moving props and equipment from the lower lot to the performance area. There is a small hill that will need to be pushed up.

Performer Re-entry:

Wristbands will be provided to each performer, and each band will receive 1 complimentary pass (wristband) for every 10 students in the band. These passes are good for admission to the spectator area. Performers are permitted to sit on the home side of the stadium, the visitors side will be closed.

Staff Viewing Area/Sound Mixing Area:

A sound mixing area will be made available near the clinicians' booth.

Field & Hash Marks:

McQueen has an artificial turf field with standard high school hash markings. **Only lightweight** items and pneumatic wheels are permitted on our newly finished track, no metal wheels and no heavy items with solid core tires. Drum Major Podiums with metal feet must be placed on a piece of plywood, which will be provided.

Clinic Format/Judging Panel:

Clinicians will provide a recorded commentary during your performance and come down to the field afterward for feedback. Please make sure your guard, percussion, and winds split off into separate areas to work with their respective clinicians.

- Bring the drumline to the front in an arc behind the Front Ensemble.
- Winds on side 2 facing endzone.
- Guard on side 1 facing endzone.


