Check-in:

Located on the corner of 17th and Stadium Way (map attached)

Ensemble Parking Information:

All performing groups will have assigned parking in the Green Parking Lot above the Post Office and University Central Receiving. Parking Map is attached.

NO Staff or Volunteers will monitor the Ensemble Parking Lot due to staff shortages for the WPMB. Ensemble directors should review the assigned parking map and **ONLY** park buses, trailers, and trucks in assigned spots. **Student vehicles need to be parked in West Stadium.**

Restrooms:

Port-a-Potties will be open in the assigned parking lot. Additional restrooms will be open inside Mackay Stadium on the PressBox side.

Health & Safety:

REMSA will be on call.

Hospitality:

There will be no director hospitality. Concessions will be open in the North End Zone

Music Warm Up Areas:

Warm-up areas and times are assigned to each group in the Parking Lot North of the bus and equipment truck parking lot. Extra warm-up space is available in the Tan Lot near the School of Medicine (North East of bus parking).

Props and other Equipment:

Prop and Large Equipment can be staged just inside Gate 10 (Performer Entry Gate).

Performer Re-entry:

Directors will receive performer wristbands for performers to enter the stadium through Gate 2.

Staff Viewing Area/Sound Mixing Area:

Staff are allowed in the press box (level 3) for viewing during the show. A sound mixing area is reserved at the top of the plastic blue seats on the 50-yard line.

Field & Hash Marks:

White NCAA College Hash Marks are permanent on the field. High School Hash Marks will be in blue painter's tape and checked after each performance.

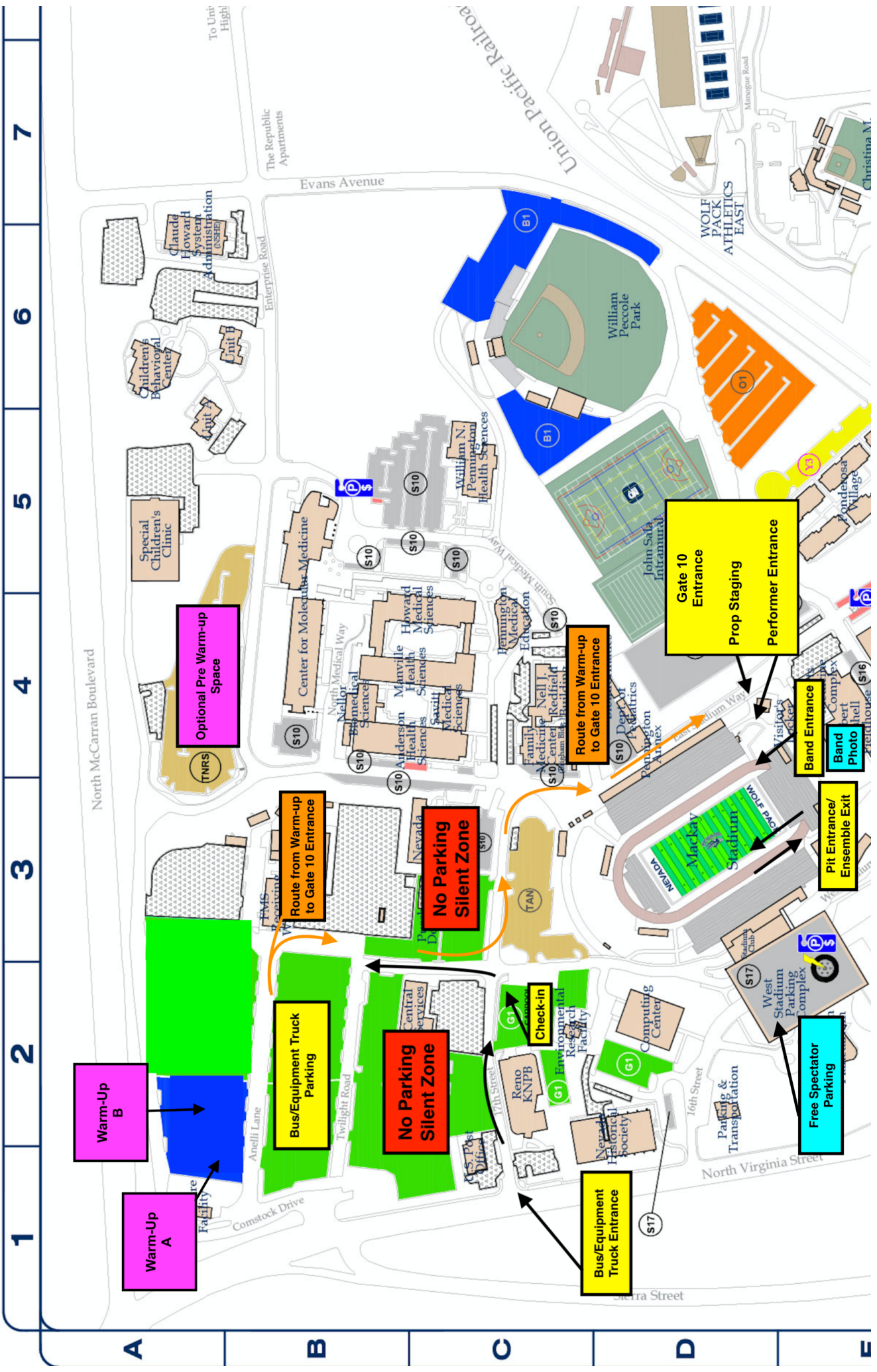

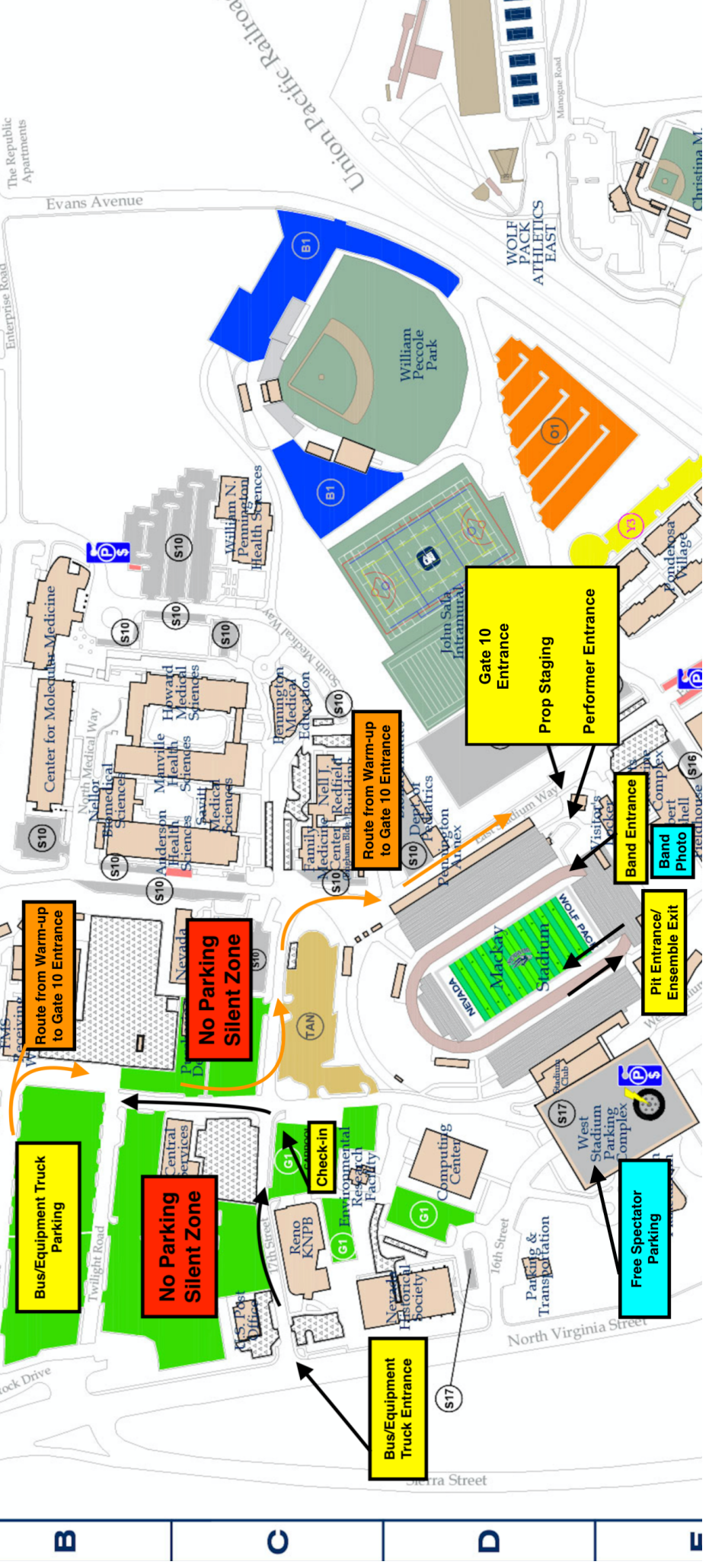

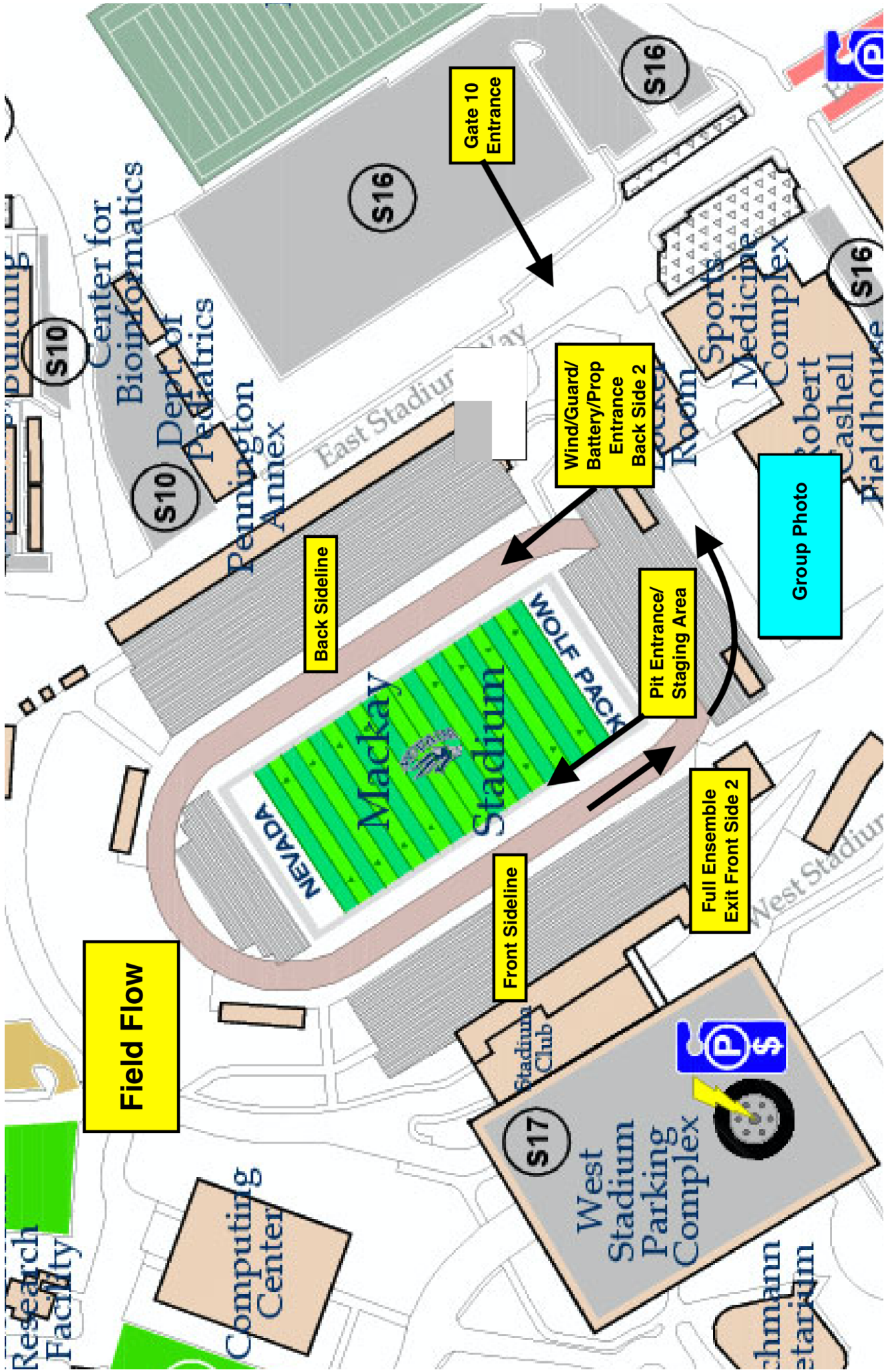
